

The collaborative research agreement with Cancer Research Initiatives Foundation  
(CARIF)

Nimura Genetic Solutions Co. Ltd. (also known as NGS; Tokyo, Japan) has signed a contractual agreement with Cancer Research Initiatives Foundation (CARIF) for the collaboration research of the photosensitizer through Nimura Genetic Solutions (M) Sdn. Bhd.. The purpose of this research is searching the photosensitizer from the soil microorganisms for photodynamic therapy.

CARIF, established in 2002, is one of the leading non-profit cancer research organizations in Malaysia, which is funded by contribution from private entities and government's grants. The research field is related to oral cancer and nasopharyngeal cancer, which belong to high disease rate of cancer groups among cancer patients, typically for a developing country. CARIF is searching for photosensitizer from the natural product, for utilizing it to photodynamic therapy which is noteworthy as a non side effect therapy.
